**Councillors**

I have received the **ATTACHED** correspondence **ATTACHMENT 1** from the Australia-East Timor Association (AETA) requesting support for a seminar entitled “Humanitarian Responses to the East Timor Crisis” to be held on Saturday 15 July 2006 at Petersham Town Hall and followed by an acoustic Benefit Concert.

The AETA (NSW) is a voluntary, non party-political body that responds to requests for assistance from members and supporters working in Dili. Official UNHCR estimates now indicate that there are more than 140 000 displaced people in East Timor and that food, water and shelter is in short supply. AETA indicates that it has been informed by the major Non Government Organisations (NGOs) providing assistance in East Timor from Australia that response to their television appeals for financial assistance has been slow. It is for this reason that AETA has requested support from Marrickville Council.

The AETA has sought a waiver of the normal hall hire fee for Petersham Town Hall, funding for the creation of a banner and flyers publicising the event, and suggested a Mayoral/Council Dinner for the East Timorese Ambassador to Australia.

Given Council’s proud record of involvement in refugee issues, including publication of a Refugee Position Paper, support of UNHCR World Refugee Day and its status as a Refugee Welcome Zone, I propose that Council support the Seminar proposed by the AETA through in kind donations.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

**THAT** Council:

1. waive the normal Hall hire fee for the seminar;
2. display a banner, publicising the event from Petersham Town Hall from 8 July to 16 July 2006; and
3. issue a Press Release publicising the seminar and highlighting the current situation in East Timor.

**Synopsis**

A Mayoral Minute requests that Council endorse a request from Mr Jefferson Lee of the Australian East Timor Association (NSW) for support for a seminar entitled “Humanitarian Responses to the East Timor Crisis” to be held on Saturday 15 July 2006 at Petersham Town Hall and followed by an acoustic Benefit Concert. The request is for Council to waive the normal Hall hire fee (\$406) for Petersham Town Hall as well as the cost of producing and hanging a banner publicising the event provided by AETA from Petersham Town Hall (\$1,250). This represents a total cost of \$1,656.

**Background**

The Community Grants Policy, which was endorsed by Council at the Community Services Committee meeting of 13 September 2005 (Item CD 20, 08/05) represents Council’s requirement to treat all donations for cash or in kind support under a coherent policy framework. This includes requests under the Community Grants Program, the Contingency Program and Notices of Motion.

In 2005/06, \$5,000 is set aside for cash or in kind donations that are brought to Council as Notices of Motion. Funds for the Community Grants Program and Contingency Program have been exhausted for this financial year.

**Discussion**

To assist Council in its decision making an assessment against the Eligibility Criteria under the Community Grants Policy in the **ATTACHED** schedule (**Attachment 1**).

**Conclusion**

The Community Grants Policy sets a \$1,000 limit on donations of cash or in kind support arising from a Notice of Motion, however, Council can resolve to provide additional funding at its discretion. The in kind contribution sought by AETA amounts to \$1,656.

**SUMMARY OF ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ORGANISATIONS REQUESTING DONATIONS UNDER THE COMMUNITY GRANTS PROGRAM, PART 3, NOTICES OF MOTION**

<b>Eligibility Criteria</b>	<b>Australia-East Timor Association (AETA)</b>
Applicants must be non-profit community organisations who provide services and programs that benefit residents in the Marrickville LGA.	✓  The seminar is to take place in Marrickville (Petersham Town Hall).
Evidence must be provided that the organisation is appropriately incorporated, community based and not conducted for private gain.	✓
Applications must be for specific projects and cannot be considered as a permanent source of funding. Grants will not be given to cover a shortfall in the applicant organisation's general running costs.	✓
Grants will not be provided to political parties.	✓
The organisation must demonstrate a capacity to deliver community services or programs.	✓
