Councillors

Councillors are aware of the proposal put forward recently by members of the community and considered by Council regarding the creation of a small public space where people can sit or congregate at Seaview St, Dulwich Hill.

Although Council has requested options to be investigated and that will be done as part of the ageing strategy, it has raised awareness of another location close by that could accommodate such a purpose.

The area in front of Dulwich Hill Library and the gates of the Seaview St Community Hall could provide a recreational area through the placement of tables and seating, an appropriate shade structure, landscaping and the partial extension of the existing disability access ramp.

Preliminary cost estimates of the type of work required suggest a figure of approximately \$30,000 with a DA required depending on the type of shade structure required.

The area includes some mature trees and some garden landscaping which would be enhanced by such works. The development of this area would also provide an outdoor area that could be utilized by library users.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council seek a detailed report from Council officers about establishing a passive recreation area at the front of the Dulwich Hill Branch Library and the Seaview Street Community Hall for the use of residents with a particular emphasis on older residents.
