Background

As Council progresses toward sign off on the Callan Park Draft Master plan, Draft Plan of Management and the Conservation Management Plan, the opportunity exists to investigate ways to ensure that management of this site is coordinated and coherent at both the strategic level and in terms of operational management.

The broader strategic governance of Callan Park is discussed in the draft Master plan.

In terms of day-to-day operational management of a large site like Callan Park, an environment where there are many users, this needs to be coordinated and all stakeholders should work together to achieve the best outcomes for the site.

As such, Council in conjunction with the Sydney Harbour Foreshores Authority (SHFA), should establish the Callan Park/Broughton Hall Management Committee which will include representatives from:

- the Sydney College of the Arts
- the Writers Centre
- University of Tasmania
- each of the NGOs
- NSW Health
- NSW Ambulance, security services
- Leichhardt Council
- SHFA

- Security services and
- key community groups

Standing items on the agenda for this committee might include items such as:

- amenity – lighting, seats, pathways
- waste collection and services
- grounds maintenance
- infrastructure works
- events scheduled
- traffic and access
- security

It is expected that reports from this committee would provide useful information for the Callan Park governance body, once established.

Recommendation:
